Do you remember when the Nintendo came out in the early 1980s? Excite Bike and Contra were by far my favorite games, although my parents never let me have one. They said it was too expensive, and that a newer, more high-tech version would come out in a few years anyway. Well, as much as we thought our parents didn't know anything when we were kids, they were right. A few years later the Super Nintendo was released. Then it was the Nintendo 64, then the Game Cube. As I grew up during these releases, I started noticing a repeated trend with Nintendos: as old versions became less novel and more out-of-date, a new version would be released to kill off the old. For example, when the Super Nintendo came out, it cost around \$200. Once everyone who already had an NES bought the new Super Nintendo, prices dropped to around \$150. After a couple years, you could pick up a new Super Nintendo for \$100. That's when Nintendo 64 came out, and it followed the same cyclical pattern. This cycle that Nintendo has gone through several times and will continue to go through is called the product life cycle. But Nintendo products aren't the only ones that go through the product life cycle. Virtually every product has a life cycle, especially in a competitive market for that product.
