Most American young people live independently after marriage. According to statistics, in the early 1970s, only 1.5 percent of all married couples were not living on their own. Most newly married couples set up their own household immediately and begin to make plans for the future. Most married couples practise some kind of birth control. In most states, birth control information is easily available and the birth rate has been declining steadily in recent years.

c. The gap between the poor and the rich is striking. In American society, equality is greatly advocated. However, social equality has never been realized. When we say equality in economy, we mean the equality of opportunity in theory. Ideally, each has as good a chance as everyone else of achieving wealth by his own efforts; everyone is independent, and free to choose his own position in society. But this is not always true. The son of a banker may find it easier to be successful for several reasons. Therefore, equality doesn't mean all Americans are equal economically.
