A United Nations peacekeeping operation should only use forceas a measure of last resort , when other methods of persuasion havebeen exhausted , and an operation must always exercise restraintwhen doing so. The ultimate aim of the use of force is to influenceand deter spoilers working against the peace process or seeking toharm civilians: and not to seek their military defeat. The use of forceby a United Nations peacekeeping operation should always be calibra-ted in a precise , proportional and appropriate manner , within the principle of the minimum force necessary to achieve the desiredeffect , while sustaining consent for the mission and its mandate. Inits use of force , a United Nations peacekeeping operation should al-ways be mindful of the need for an early de-escalation of violence and a return to non-violent means of persuasion. The use of force by a United Nations peacekeeping operation al-ways has political implications and can often give rise to unforeseencircumstances. Judgments concerning its use will need to be made at the appropriate level within a mission , based on a combination of fac-tors including mission capability~ public perceptions~ humanitarianimpact~ force protection~ safety and security of personnel~ and , mostimportantly , the effect that such action will have on national and lo-cal consent for the mission.
