## 前言

作为一套供网络教育专升本以及高升本学生使用的英语教材,《英语实用教程》自出版以来一直得到广大师生的热情支持。

在出版近十年之际,我们对原有教材进行了内容和形式上的全面更新,根据国家网络教育考试委员会制定颁布的网络教育统考课程考试大纲,编写了《新编英语实用教程》。

《新编英语实用教程》充分考虑网络教育的特点,即成人学习、业余学习和网络学习。在教程的编写中,结合网络教育学生的实际水平,针对自学为主的需求,充分利用多媒体教学手段,帮助学生掌握相关词汇和语法知识,培养和训练读、写、译、说的技能。

教程共四册,包括:《新编英语实用教程》(配有光盘)(1、2册)和《新编英语实用教程学习指导书》(1、2册),教学PPT课件及其他相关参考资料也将陆续推出。

《新编英语实用教程》紧扣新颁布的统考大纲,重点突出,内容精炼。

按照大纲词汇表编排教材词汇:以大纲中大学英语C级词汇作为学生已掌握的基本词汇,在此基础上,分别列出大学英语B级词汇以及超纲词(带\*的单词)。

标识清楚,词义全面,例句充分,方便学生学习、掌握大纲所要求的词汇、短语及其用法。

按大纲中所包含题型——交际英语、阅读、完形填空、词汇语法、翻译、写作——在本教程各单元练习中均有体现,既使学生熟悉统考题型,也训练学生掌握各种技能,并在此基础上熟练运用解题技巧。

《新编英语实用教程》采用主题教学模式,即每个单元的课文设置围绕一个主题,提供大量相互联系的语言样本,词汇的复现率高。

根据语言认知理论,反复的、同~主题的语言输入有助于学生对所学语言内容的消化和吸收。

本教程选材新颖,内容丰富,趣味性、知识性强,能激发学生的自学兴趣。

## 内容概要

本书为《新编英语实用教程》学生用书第2册，共分为十个单元，每单元由四个部分组成，即Focus on

Reading, Focus on Grammar, Focus on Writing和Focus on Speaking。

第一部分FoCUS on Reading包括三篇文章：Basic Reading(基本阅读课文), Extensive Reading(泛读课文)和Supplementary Reading(补充阅读)。

Basic Reading为主课文，是每个单元学习的重点，包括生词表、注释、课文理解练习、词汇语法练习、翻译练习以及完形填空练习。

Extensive Reading作为主课文的补充，同样配有课文理解练习、词汇语法练习、翻译练习。

Supplementary Reading采用一篇短文配五个阅读理解选择题的形式，可用作学生对自己阅读理解能力的自测。

本教程根据网络教育学生的特点和需要，增设Focus on Grammar，即语法知识体系的介绍以及配套的练习。

其后的Focus on Writing提供作文题目以及中英文的参考词汇；Focus on Speaking则按照交际功能划分，各单元该部分内容由一段对话和数道交际英语练习题组成。

## 章节摘录

Walter Peeters, dean of the International Space University in Strasbourg, said that what has been regarded as the stuff of science fiction is close to becoming reality. He is among a number of scientists who are convinced that "space tourism" and sub-orbital point to point travel (SPTP) are on the Point of becoming a flourishing industry.<sup>4</sup> The former is aimed at the rich who are able to dig deep in their pockets for the experience of space travel which on Virgin Galactic<sup>5</sup> is \$200,000 or around 125,000. But this is just a staging post for the ultimate goal, traveling through space to get from one side of the globe to the other in a couple of hours.<sup>6</sup>

The advocates of SPTP see it as the 21st century equivalent of taking a trip on Concorde—and appealing to the same sort of clients.<sup>7</sup> But such travel will not come cheap. One estimate suggests a ticket for a round trip taking in London, Tokyo and New York would cost more than \$43,000.<sup>8</sup> Mr. Peeters, however, thinks that the fares in the middle of the next decade will be the equivalent of what passengers were paying to fly on Concorde during its peak hours.<sup>9</sup> The fares would also be comparable to the amount of money which people paid to take the first transatlantic flight in 1939.
