A great deal of the knowledge we have about household goods derives largely from the advertisements we read .

Advertisements introduce US to new products or remind US of the existence of ones we already know about . Supposing you wanted to buy a washing- machine , it is more than likely you would obtain details regarding performance , price , etc . from an advertisement . Lots of people pretend that they never read advertisements , but this claim may be seriously doubted . It is hardly possible not to read advertisements these days, And what fun they often are , too! Just think what a railway station or a newspaper would be like without advertisements . Would you enjoy gazing at a blank wall or reading railway by-laws while waiting for a train? Would you like to read only closely-printed columns of news in your daily paper? A cheerful , witty advertisement makes such a difference to a drab wall or a newspaper full of the daily ration of calamities .
