版权页： 插图： Reading: Host and Hostess Job Description Restaurant hosts and hostesses serve as personal representatives of the restaurant for which they work. They are in charge of making reservations and greeting guests when they arrive at the restaurant. They also seat the guests and make sure that they enjoy their meal. Hosts and hostesses try to give guests a good impression about the restaurant by greeting them in a warm, friendly manner. If guests have to wait to be seated, hosts and hostesses should make them comfortable while they are waiting. The guest is given an idea of how long they have to wait and where they are seated in a waiting area. Sometimes hosts and hostesses suggest that the diners wait at the bar and have a drink. Hosts and hostesses locate a table which is the right size for the guest, take the guest to the table and give them the menu. They may also assist guests in seating small children, or fill their water glasses. While greeting incoming guests, hosts and hostesses also must take care of those who are leaving.
