章节摘录

In addition to his desire to reform and centralize the legal system, Henry also hoped to re-assert control of the Church. However, the process of strengthening the royal courts yielded an unexpected controversy. The church courts, instituted by William the Conqueror for justice, ironically became a safe haven for criminals of varying degree and ability as church courts had exclusively right of justice. Extending the jurisdiction of the King's courts brought conflict with his close friend and chosen archbishop, Thomas Becket. The bitter contest between them was finally put to an end when four ambitious knights murdered Becket in his own cathedral on December 29, 1170. Becket had preached against the King's reforms in Canterbury Cathedral, after which the exasperated king hastily and publicly conveyed his wish to be rid of the contentious Archbishop. This event outraged all Christendom, and Henry had to reconcile with the Pope by promising financial aid to the Crusade. Henry endured a rather limited storm of protest over the incident and the controversy passed. &hellip;&hellip;
