The EU hasnot declared a capital formally , though the Treaty of Amster-dam formally gives Brussels the seat of the European Com-mission ( the executive/government branch ) and the Council of the European Union ( a legislative institution made up fromleaders of member states ) . It locates the formal seat of Eu-ropean Parliament in the French city of Strasbourg , wherevotes take place with the Council on the proposals made bythe Commission.
