版权页：A top-notch advisory council had given the warning to the Central Government, which was urgently asked to prevent the possibility. The expert panel of China Council for International Cooperation on the Environment and Development had submitted a suggestion package to Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao and listed local governments' poor environmental awareness as a "major risk." "The Central Governments should strengthen inspections to prevent the local governments from taking risks to stabilize economic growth at the cost of environmental protection," the proposed package said. The panel voiced its concern that some local governments were still holding the age-old mindset that higher economic growth was a priority despite the fact that a nationwide campaign to promote sustainable development and harmony had been ongoing for years.
