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前言

《实用综合教程》是根据教育部颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求(试行)》的精神 ,结合我国高职高专公共英语教学实际编写的,其基本指导思想是以学生在中学阶段学到的英语为起 点,提供听说读写译技能的基础性综合训练,注重实际应用,培养学生一定的语言运用能力。

从我国高职高专学校开设公共英语课程的实际情况出发,同时考虑到我国各地区和各学校之间的 差异,《实用综合教程》一共编写4册,一学期使用一本,各本教材相互之间为递进关系。

对于英语水平较低的新生,第一学期可以选用第一册,用三个学期学完第一、二、三册后,要求能达到《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求(试行)》规定的"基本要求",可以通过高等学校英语应用能力考试(B级)。

对于英语水平较好的新生,第一学期可以从第二册开始使用,学生学完第三册后,可以通过高等学校 英语应用能力考试(B级)。

第四册为选修教材,供学有余力的学生使用。

学生学完全部四册后,要求能达到《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求(试行)》规定的"较高要求",可以通过高等学校英语应用能力考试(A级)。

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内容概要

系列教材以《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求(试行)》为编写依据,融合传统与现代教学理念,强调语言基础知识的掌握,突出语言应用能力的培养。
