We hear such opinions as "French people are romantic", "Italians are passionate", "Germans are logical and orderly", "Chinese are inscrutableand mysterious", etc. These characterisations —— whether positive or negative —— fall into the category of simplistic stereotypes. What about stereotypes about Americans?

Whatgeneralisations do other cultures have about the typicalAmerican?

Unfortunately, many of the stereotypes aboutAmericans fit into a sort of Ugly American stereotype. For example, in the book Managing Cultural Differences, intercultural experts Philip R. Harris and Robert T. Moranlist some opinions that Arab businessmen hold regarding their dealings with Westerners.
