## 内容概要

《新编高等高专旅游管理类专业规划教材：旅游接待英语》系统地介绍了涉外旅游接待工作的基本知识、基本技能及服务理念，涵盖旅游业各个环节，从实际出发，将专业基础知识与英语交际能力有机结合，重视案例教学与模拟训练，具有明确的职业导向性，是实用型旅游英语教材。本教材适合高职院校旅游专业、旅游英语专业学生及有志于从事涉外旅游工作的人士选用。

Irregardless of their reasons for travel, for travelers intending to stay overnight at their destination, their first concern is to find comfortable accommodations. The lodging industry provides many options to cater to different needs. Deluxe hotels provide a wide range of services in order to make the guest's stay comfortable and enjoyable. Full Independent Tourists or FITs, may prefer lodging with friends and family, staying in self-catering apartments or even villas for holidays at resort areas. As a result of mass tourism, family inns are becoming popular at many tourist destinations. Motels, hostels, youth apartments, guesthouses, and inns are also good choices for tourists who want to save their lodging expenses. Most of the time, star hotels cater to foreigners by providing food, lodging and many other services which meet international standards. The hotel industry spends millions of dollars each year to keep equipment and furnishings up to date. Generally, hotels can be classified into four categories: commercial, resort, conventional and residential. The hotels that cater most to business people are known as commercial hotels. Those for people on vacation are called vacation or resort hotels. Convention hotels host conventions, forums or seminars. Residential hotels are designed to serve people who want to live in a hotel for an extended period of time. Nonetheless, each of these types of hotels is a temporary home, so the facilities and services should be geared to provide the greatest level of comfort and convenience.

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
