章节摘录

"Family" is surely an elastic word. But when British people say that their society is based on family life, they are thinking of "family" in its narrow, peculiarly European sense of mother, father and children living together alone in their own house as an economic and social unit. Thus, each British marriage suggests the starting of a new and independent family—and then, the tremendous significance of marriage in British life. For both the man and the woman, marriage means going away from one's parents and starting one's own life. From that moment on, the man's first duty will be to his wife, and the same is to the wife. He will have a total responsibility for her financial support, and she for the running of the new home. They together will be responsible for their children as well as alone. Neither the wife's parents nor the husband's, nor their brothers or sisters, aunts or uncles, have any right to interfere with them—they are their own masters. Readers of novels like Jane Austen's *Pride and Prejudice* know that in the past the girls' parents made arrangements on marriage among wealthy families, that is, it was the parents' duty to find a suitable husband for their daughter, preferably a rich one, and by skillful encouragement to lead him in the end to ask their permission of marrying her. Before that, the girl was protected and maintained in the parents' home, and the relief of getting rid of her in finance could be seen in their giving the newly married couple an amount of money called a dowry. Today it's very different. Most girls now get a job when they graduate and before they get married, they are financially independent. This has caused two results. A girl chooses her own husband, and she gets no dowry.
