This epoch-making document falls into two parts. The first part tells of the rights that belong to everybody. It solemnly declared: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness..." The second part recounts the wrongs the British did against his colonies. The Declaration of Independence marked the beginning of a new nation—the United States of America. It was a masterpiece of bourgeois political philosophy. The influence of the Declaration spread far beyond America boundaries.

3. Social Class Social class is a group of people differentiated loosely from other groups in terms of wealth, position, and power. From the Marxist point of view, classes are determined primarily according to "the relations of production" of a given society, that is, according to an examination of who owns the means of production and who operates the means of production. The theory of class currently prevailing in the West is largely based on what Max Weber (1864 ~ 1930), a German sociologist, proposed. His theory holds that men in every society are evaluated by their fellow men on a number of structural bases. That is, they are evaluated in terms of their profession, their social status, their membership in a family or ethnic body, and their knowledge or education.
