The bad news is that each year reviewers reject hundreds of thousands of medical manuscripts. The good news is that many are rejected for common flaws that can be avoided. Several books have described how to write a scientific paper, notably those by Robert Day (1994), Edward Huth (1990), and George Hall (1994). My goal in writing *Publishing Your Medical Research Paper: What They Don't Teach in Medical School* was to exserach study and writing a publishable paper.
