To the desert peoples , eating the meat of young goats —— and with their rigorous sense of hospitality , offering it to their guests + is an integral part of life. Goats and rice are part of their social ecology , their traditional system of values and beliefs , their relationship with the world. Young men who leave for the city change this traditional relationship in many ways , in the matter of food by turning to dried milk , white bread , and Pepsi-Cola. What is available , what they can afford , what their peers are buying —— these are just a few of the factors at play. In the industrialized world , dietary folklore itself is all but swept away before the brooms of the newer sciences —— biochemistry , physiology , and statistics.
